

# KIDGAB Monitoring Guide for Parents

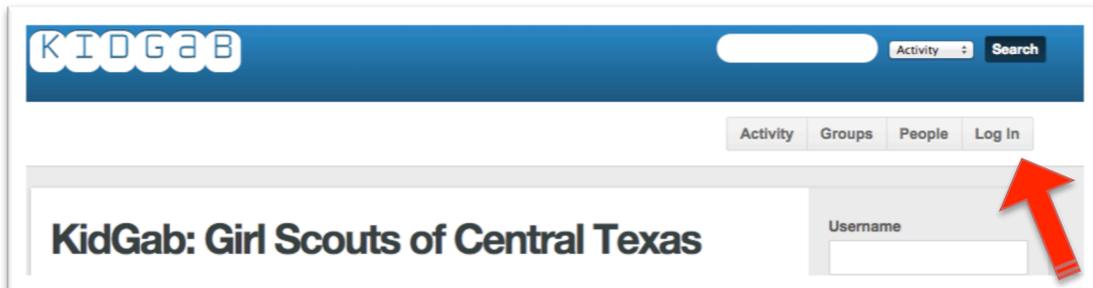
## STEP 1: KNOW WHAT YOU'RE LOOKING FOR

When you monitor your child's online activity, ask yourself four questions:

1. **Who is your child communicating with?** What do you know about his/her communication partners? Show as much interest in your child's online friends as you do his/her neighborhood friends.
2. **Is your child revealing too much information?** Has your child mentioned real names, addresses, phone numbers, birthdays, genders, physical locations, or any other information that could identify him/her individually?
3. **Is your child being cyberbullied?** Has anyone else posted anything mean, hurtful, or threatening about or to your child?
4. **Is your child cyberbullying?** Has your child posted anything that could be considered mean, hurtful, or threatening?

## STEP 2: LOG IN TO KIDGAB

In the top right-hand corner of your screen, click the "Log In" button.



Then, enter your username and password into the provided textboxes.

- If you are a parent, your username will be your child's username with "\_parent" added to the end. So if your child's username is "girlscout", your username is "girlscout\_parent".
- Your password is preset to be "**password**", but you should change this immediately upon logging in.

## STEP 3: NAVIGATE TO YOUR CHILD'S PROFILE

On any page within KidGab, you can navigate to your child's profile page. You can find the link on the left side of your top menu. If you have more than one child, a link for each will be available.
